Dear **Corniche Sur Mer** Resident,

It is time for the Association to renew its resident on-street parking permit program, which will be effective **May 1, 2016**. The 2016 resident parking program has been upgraded and will utilize the approved vehicle license plate as your overnight parking permit, which means no more decals. The 2015 decals will no longer be valid after April 30, 2016. Although very similar to the current permit program there are some significant changes, **so please read the program details carefully.**

HOW WILL YOUR APPROVED RESIDENT VEHICLE LICENSE PLATE ACT AS AN OVERNIGHT PARKING PERMIT?

Once an on-street parking application (attached) is approved, the vehicle license plate number will be linked to your address and entered into the Patrol One system as authorized to be parked overnight. No decal will need to be placed on the authorized resident's vehicle. The authorized license plate number will act as the permit allowing the vehicle to be parked overnight.

WHAT RESIDENT VEHICLE NEEDS TO BE PERMITTED?

Resident vehicle(s) parked in common area open parking at any time between the hours of 12:00 AM and 6:00 AM must be permitted. All unpermitted resident vehicles will be subject to a citation and/or tow. The procedures for obtaining a permit are described in the attached Application for On-Street Parking Permit.

PLEASE NOTE: Any vehicle displaying a 2015 red decal after April 30, 2016 which has not obtained a 2016 authorized license plate permit will be subject to citation and/or towing.
